POTABLE (DRINKING) WATER RESTRICTIONS

Effective April 21, 2009 – per Town of Belleair Commission Resolution No. 2009-10

LAWN & LANDSCAPE WATERING SCHEDULE, using an in-ground irrigation system, is limited to ONE (1) DAY PER WEEK, AS FOLLOWS:

the number 2 or 3
the number 4 or 5
the number 6 or 7
the number 8 or 9
mixed or no address, subdivision common areas

May Water On

- Watering is limited to one application per week

If your property is	Then you may use your sprinkling system:
Less than one acre	12:01 AM to 4:00 AM
One acre or larger	12:01 AM to 4:00 AM and 8:00 PM to 11:59 PM

- Sprinkler system irrigation is prohibited between the hours of 4:00 AM and 8:00 PM
- Only on the authorized one-day-per-week, lawns can be irrigated by hand watering with a sprinkling can, a hose equipped with an automatic cancelling nozzle, or a portable sprinkler from 6 AM to 8 AM and from 6 PM to 10 PM.

RESIDENTIAL CAR WASHING and PRESSURE CLEANING are allowed

BUT

NO WATERING is allowed on Saturdays and Sundays

NO CHARITY CAR WASHES are allowed

<p>New Landscaping (Plants & Shrubs)</p> <p>Establishment Period Irrigation Exemption</p> <p>You must call the Water Dept. for an exemption to water at 727-588-3769 x405</p>	<p>New plant materials may be watered for a <u>60-day total</u> establishment period.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ From day 1 to day 15, new landscape may be watered every day of the week. ✓ From day 16 to day 45, new landscape may be watered 3 days per week. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Even addresses only on Tuesday, Thursday, and Saturday • Odd addresses only on Wednesday, Friday, and Sunday ✓ From day 46 to day 60, new landscape may be watered 2 days per week. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Even addresses only on Tuesday and Saturday • Odd addresses only on Wednesday and Sunday • Only during authorized hours and isolated to new plant area only. • Exemption begins on the day of installation. • On the day of installation, new plant material may be irrigated once without regard to the allowable watering times. • An entire zone of an irrigation system may be used if the zone waters an area that contains at least 50% new plant material. • Partial zone or dispersed plantings shall be watered by some other, more targeted means of supplemental irrigation.
<p>Lawn Chemicals</p>	<p>Irrigation to water-in necessary lawn chemicals is not restricted when required by the manufacturer or when required by law. Chemical applications shall be watered during authorized watering hours and on regularly designated irrigation days when possible.</p>
<p>Low-Volume Irrigation Devices for Trees, Shrubs, Flowers & Vegetables</p>	<p>Landscape (groundcover other than lawn) may be irrigated by hand watering with a sprinkling can, a hose equipped with an automatic cancelling nozzle, portable sprinkler, or micro-irrigation from 6 AM to 8 AM and from 6 PM to 10 PM on 3 days per week.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Even addresses only on Tuesday, Thursday, and Saturday ✓ Odd addresses only on Wednesday, Friday, and Sunday
<p>Irrigation System Testing & Repair</p>	<p>May be operated for cleaning and maintenance week and one test should not exceed 10 minutes.</p>

WELL WATER and LAKE/POND WATER RESTRICTIONS

Effective December 2008 – per SWFWMD Phase III Order

LAWN & LANDSCAPE WATERING SCHEDULE, using an in-ground irrigation system, is limited to ONE (1) DAY PER WEEK, as follows:

12:01 a.m. to 8:00a.m. **OR** 6:00 p.m. to 11:59 p.m.

- Watering is prohibited between the hours of 8:00 AM and 6:00 PM
- **PROPERTIES TWO (2) ACRES OR GREATER** in size may irrigate during the hours of 12:01 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. **OR** 4:00 p.m. to 11:59 p.m.

Chemical applications shall be watered during authorized watering hours and on regularly designated irrigation days when possible.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Low-Volume Irrigation Devices for Trees, Shrubs, Flowers & Vegetables</p>	<p>Landscape (groundcover other than lawn) may be irrigated as-needed basis without regard to the normal allowable watering days by hand watering with a sprinkling can, a hose equipped with an automatic cancelling nozzle, portable sprinkler, or micro-irrigation before 8 AM or after 6 AM.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Irrigation System Testing & Repair</p>	<p>May be operated for cleaning and maintenance week and one test should not exceed 10 minutes.</p>
